

Restrictions lifted, mandatory isolation in place

Mandatory isolation for COVID-19 core symptoms or a positive test remains in place in Alberta, despite the lifting of health measures earlier this week.

Alberta moved into step two of its reopening plan on Tuesday, March 1, which resulted in limits on social gatherings being lifted, as well as remaining school requirements. More information.

However, mandatory isolation periods are still in effect, as follows:

- Five days at home and five days of continued masking for fully vaccinated individuals
- 10 days for unvaccinated individuals and those who are not fully immunized (more details)

Isolation requirements.

Step three, in which mandatory isolation becomes only a recommendation, is due to come into effect at a time to be determined, based on hospitalization rates continuing to trend downwards.

Pediatric vaccination: Clinics in Calgary and the surrounding area are now offering walk-in appointments for pediatric vaccination (ages five to 11). Opening hours and dates vary.
