The COVID-19 Omicron subvariant XBB.1.5 is circulating in Alberta and is expected to become the most dominant strain provincewide.

It is not yet known how effective the bivalent booster doses are against infection with XBB.1.5. However, AHS is advising patients to get their booster, when eligible, as it is expected to provide some cross-immunity and protection. <u>More information</u>.
