



EMR survey information

In the next few days, physicians can expect to receive an EMR survey from ThinkHQ.

The intent of this survey, produced on behalf of the Physician Leads Executive, is to better understand the EMR landscape in Alberta and the related challenges and opportunities facing PCN physicians in Alberta.

The questions focus on physicians' experiences and thoughts related to the EMR system they currently use in their practice. The Physicians Leads Executive is hoping the feedback will help them identify opportunities where PCNs can better support you and each other when working with EMRs and EMR vendors.

The consolidated information will also support and inform advocacy efforts and priorities as the Alberta Medical Association works with other stakeholders (Alberta Health, Alberta Health Services, EMR vendors) in improving the digital health system in Alberta.
