

## Lab supply portal launch

Alberta Precision Laboratories' (APL) new community lab supply ordering portal will go live on Monday, April 1. To prepare for the launch, all community providers must verify their account by emailing <a href="mailto:CPSMOperations.EOC@albertahealthservices.ca">CPSMOperations.EOC@albertahealthservices.ca</a>. Failure to do so will result in the inability to access or order clinical lab test supplies. More information.

# Refocusing health update

On Thursday, March 21, Health Minister Adriana LaGrange provided an update on the government's plans for healthcare reform in Alberta.

More than 2,500 people have participated in in-person engagement sessions. About 18,000 have provided feedback virtually, with around 10,000 via virtual town halls. More sessions have been added. The government also announced that the continuing care organization rollout will also be delayed until the fall. Watch the update. Engagement opportunities.

**Decreasing administrative burden:** A report on decreasing administrative burden in primary care can be <u>downloaded here</u>. The report, prepared by the Alberta College of Family Physicians and the Alberta Medical Association, revealed that filling out forms, chasing results, completing referrals, and Connect Care and Facilitated Access to Specialized Treatment processes were among the tasks identified as contributing to increasing administrative burden. <u>More information</u>.
