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Lab Services are Changing in Alberta

The province of Alberta is transforming how laboratory services are delivered across the province, standardizing and improving patient care for all Albertans.

To make this vision a reality DynaLIFE and Alberta Precision Laboratories (APL) are working together to implement a harmonized, province-wide, lab services model.

Under this new provincial laboratory services model DynaLIFE's role will expand to a province-wide scope focusing on community lab services, while APL will support and focus on acute care lab services.

DynaLIFE's new provincial mandate will include:

- Assuming responsibility for community Patient Service Centres (PSCs) and all routine community testing.
- Coordinating mobile collections across the province.
- Providing centralized lab services appointment booking system for community patients and physicians.
- Managing province wide support and Lab Informatics service (one provincial number to call for assistance).
- Providing new online supply ordering system for physicians across the province to order lab collection supplies.
- Managing all transportation and routing of all specimens across the province.
- Assuming responsibility for operating the Calgary Hub Lab, and continuing to operate the Edmonton Hub Lab.
- Expanding laboratory capacity and investing in world-leading laboratory innovations.

At the same time, Alberta Precision Laboratories assumes responsibility for DynaLIFE's acute care services in the northeast part of the province.
