This could include help with finding a family doctor, nurse practitioner, or clinic that is taking new patients. It could also include linking you with community resources such as:

- Abuse & crisis services
- Addictions & mental health programs
- Employment services
- Finance resources
- Home care
- Indigenous health programs
- Pharmacy services
- Seniors' health programs
- Transportation resource

If you do not hear from someone within seven days, please call 403-542-0301 Monday to Friday between 8:00 am and 4:30 pm.

In the meantime, if you have concerns about your health, please call Health Link at 811. If it is a health emergency, call 911 or visit the nearest emergency department.
