TELE-ADVICE OUTCOMES



■ **101%** increase in number of patients who avoided consultation (**2,898**). Total since 2014 = **5,107**



■ **13%** decrease in number of patients who avoided emergency room visit **(1,159)**. Total since 2014 = **3,121**

TELE-ADVICE COST SAVINGS



Direct cost = \$682,746 (number of calls x physician, specialist fees) Savings = \$1.19 million (consults, ER visits, tests avoided) Net system savings = \$515,280 (+19%)

■ Net savings since 2014 = **\$1.2m**; \$2m projected by March '20
