

Patient does NOT need to be seen urgently



- ✓ Indicate a clear reason for referral and all required information outlined under mandatory info in the **provincial urology referral pathway**

- ✓ Alberta Facilitated Access to Specialized Treatment (FAST) is accepting referrals via fax. Submit your completed referral to FAST fax at **1.833.627.7023**

## EMERGENCY CONSULTATION

Patient NEEDS to be seen immediately



- ✓ Call **RAAPID** at **403.944.4486 / 1.800.661.1700** or send patient to emergency, as appropriate:
  - Send to emergency for: acute scrotal pain, testicular torsion, acute renal colic with fever, genitourinary trauma, genitourinary tract foreign body
