Addictions services

Rapid Access Addiction Medicine Program is increasing <u>capacity</u> to support patients requiring addiction support in isolation.

- Home detox where appropriate
- Medication management of addiction
- Addiction-related psychiatric and medical supports

RAAM accepts referrals from all physicians in the community.

They are also increasing capacity to support patients in supportive housing, harm reduction housing, home isolation, shelters, and any other settings where it is needed.

Rehabilitation advice

A new <u>Rehabilitation Advice Line</u>, 1-833-379-0563, can support Albertans over the age of 18 who

- · Have disabilities related to neurological conditions such as Parkinson's or MS
- · Have health conditions that affect muscles, bones and joints
- Are recovering from COVID-19

Allied health clinicians provide rehabilitation advice and information daily from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

DI, ambulatory care

Effective **Monday, May 11**, AHS and Covenant Health <u>resumed</u> some diagnostic imaging and ambulatory care services.

Patients will be contacted by a clinic or instructed to use online assessment tools. **Group visits** will be virtual, but clinics may book **face-to-face appointments** to deliver essential teaching and instruction.

DI will coordinate exam booking, contacting Albertans currently on waitlists in the coming days to reschedule their exams.

Patients requiring DI exams for surgery or urgent ambulatory care and urgent DI exams deferred due to the pandemic will be given **priority**.
