- Alberta Education released updated <u>Scenario 1 Guidelines</u> and <u>Scenario 2</u>
 <u>Guidelines</u> on Aug. 20, 2020
- All families and staff will receive a copy of the <u>Self Screening Questionnaire</u> (updated Aug. 20)
 - Implementation
 - Testing and self-isolation requirements
- Masks in Schools Alberta Education has mandated masks Gr. 4 12. School authorities have taken various approaches to masking for students in K 3
 - Significant support for mask protocols, mask breaks, and guidance for what must be in place to remove a mask and utilize alternative health measures



Key Areas of Focus for School Authorities

- Training and building understanding and implementation of all health protocols in the context of a school setting
 - Physical distancing
 - Hand hygiene
 - Cohorts
 - Masks
 - Respiratory etiquette
- Increased cleaning measures (HTP)
- Monitoring health of students and staff
- Adjustment of course delivery and schedule of school day
- Supporting learning continuity and mental health



Online access

- Classroom/course teachers will provide access to ongoing learning if students are required to self-isolate provided they are well enough to continue school work
- Transition to full registration for online schools
- Registration in the Hub where students are able to return in February.
- Continued preparation should we have to transition to a blended model in Scenario 2

Working together

- Common messages to support families and employees to make decisions regarding health concerns, required supports, and exemptions/accommodations
- Documentation expectations
