





The 2020-2021 Alberta Influenza Immunization program is now available.

Influenza immunization is more important this season, than ever before.

All Albertans, six months of age and older, are eligible to be immunized, free of charge; however, this year, AHS is working with pharmacists and physicians to offer immunization to different age groups and demographics. See details below.

## **Immunization Eligibility & Access**

Through AHS: Via pre-booked appointment only, to:

- Children under five years of age and their family and household members
- Those who are eligible to receive influenza immunization through AHS are required to book an AHS appointment using the <u>online booking tool</u>.
- Please note: No drop-in immunizations at any AHS clinic for influenza immunization.

### Through other providers:

- Pharmacists: All Albertans five years of age and older
- Physicians: All Albertans 9 years of age and older. Some physicians may be offering vaccines to children 6 months up to and including 8 years of age as well, please check with your physician's office
